

<u>No pet insurance company will cover pre-</u> <u>existing conditions.</u>

All pet insurance companies will require you to pay for the entire invoice, then they will send you a reimbursement check after receiving your pet's claim form.





NAIL TRIMMING




The Blood Supply (Kwik) in a short nail.




Note how the Blood Supply gets longer as the nail grows.

A cut here will cause Bleeding and the nail will still be too long.


> Trim here, and the blood supply will get shorter.



If you clip or file, a little bit off the long nail, every few days, the blood supply will continute to recede.



As the nail gets shorter



Only when the nail is kept short, can it be trimmed without bleeding. If the same cut had been made on the long nail in number 2, it would have caused bleeding.

HOW TO TRIM DOG NAILS

Get your dog used to having their feet touched from an early age!

Use sharp nail clippers to cut the tips of each nail at a slight angle.

If you accidently cut into the quick, apply kwik-stop powder (or cornstarch or baking powder) and apply pressure.

The breath test

Sniff your pet's breath. Normal dog and cat breath isn't particularly fresh-smelling, but if it's especially offensive then it is a good idea to get them checked out by a vet.


The breath test

Once a week, lift the lips and examine your pet's gums and teeth. The gums should be pink not red. The teeth should be mostly white without large amounts of brown tartar.




Tooth decay

Bacteria and plaque can harden into tartar, possibly causing gingivitis, receding gums, and tooth loss



LOOK FOR THE VOHC SEAL!





The VOHC seal (Veterinary Oral Health Council) is a badge of approval for pet dental products. When you see this seal on a product, it means that it has been tested and shown to help reduce plaque and tartar buildup on pets' teeth.
